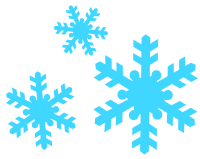
PETS ON CAMPUS. Reminder: Pets are not to be brought onto school grounds without permission from the office. Thank you for your understanding.

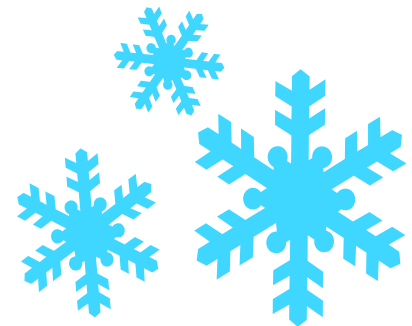
