Dear Mountain Oak Community,

For those of you who were unable to attend last Tuesday's meeting the following is a brief overview from the meeting.

Budget shortfall for this school year is \$40,600 due to Title I, Tax-Credit and Enrollment. The school has frozen supplies, facility funds, candidate and admin. travel, one classroom aide has exited and other line items cut. Those cuts leave the school in need of \$17,000 to offset:

- Loss of assistants for Specialty Classes
- Current year Pay cuts for salaried employees and potentially hourly employees
- Loss of Professional Development Money for Class Teachers

What you can do to help:

- Bring in 2010 tax-credits
- Be very pro-active with the Silent Auction, (selling tickets, bringing in items or services and attending)
- Do 35 hours of Parent Partnership Volunteer hours (call and ask what you can do around campus)

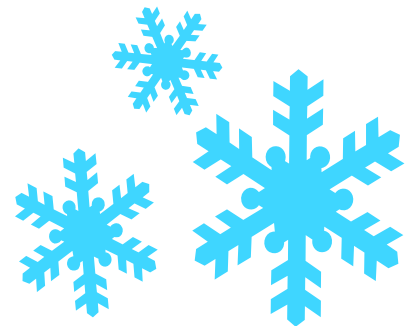
